### **Topic Plan by Subject**

**Mathematics** – writing numbers in words & figures, odd & even numbers, comparing & ordering numbers, addition, subtraction, multiplication, timetables & problem solving

**Grammar** – identifying nouns, adjectives, verbs, singular & plural

**Composition** – sentence structures, sequencing, punctuation, paragraphing, planning & writing an essay

**Comprehension** – various passages that target the following skill areas: explicit information, main idea, drawing conclusions, cause & effect and sequence

**R.S.V.P.** – various word list, blending, etc.

**Sign Language** – understanding deafness & the deaf person, do's & don'ts in deaf culture, alphabet, numbers 1-20, learning to spell one's name, colours, animals, family, greetings, things we can see, conveying ideas with sketch, conveying ideas with mime

**Spanish** – greetings, basic conversation, basic salsa steps & Spanish music, feelings, days, months, time, household items, clothing, body parts, numbers 1-100, alphabet, phrases & questions

**Cooking** – Theory (kitchen safety, food handling, food groups, nutrients, calories & food allergies)

Practical (pizza, fruit kebabs, cucumber sandwiches, bake potatoes & bake chicken, pancakes, subs, lemonade, wraps)

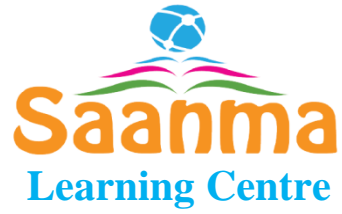
**Art & Craft** – picture frames, salt dough, felt pillows, piggy banks, teddy bears, peacock pop-up cards, paper beads necklace & bracelet, fluffy balls, tie-dye, plastic canvas
